### Therapies / Rehabilitation services

Includes physiotherapy, Occupational therapy, podiatry, orthotics, dietetics and (Speech and Language Therapy (SALT)

Deliver a range of therapeutic services from the new building



### Women's services

Includes ante-natal, post-natal, pregnancy assessment unit, colposcopy and sexual health

Deliver a range of services from the new building



### Outpatient services

Wide range of services such as, Audiology, Cardiology, Diabetes, Dermatology, Ear, Nose and Throat and Retinal Screening

Deliver a range of outpatient services on site with options for virtual consultations



### Diagnostic services

X-ray, Ultrasound and Echo

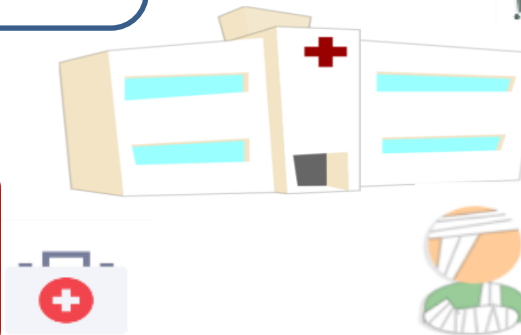
Ultrasound, x-ray and echo with opportunity for further diagnostic provision



### Minor surgery services

Procedures on superficial areas of the body which can safely be performed in community settings including GP practices. E.g. Mole removal,

Minor surgery provision to include skin and plastics



### Urgent Care services

Illness or injury that requires urgent treatment but is not life threatening – broken bone

Urgent care on site  
8am-8pm  
Home visiting overnight

### Chemotherapy and Medical Investigations Unit

Chemotherapy is a drug treatment used by cancer patients. MIU carries out specialised tests

Dedicated chemotherapy unit. Dedicated Medical Investigations Unit (MIU)



### Community beds service

16 bedded rehabilitation unit

16 beds available for 'step-down' from acute settings (e.g. UHND) as well as 'step-up' from primary care services
